What are Family Case Planning Conferences (FCPCs)?

FCPCs are meetings where parents, social workers, and other support people share information, talk about challenges, and make short-term plans. They are run by a facilitator who helps everyone share their perspectives.



What are the benefits of FCPCs?



Can be quickly scheduled



Address key issues in a short session (1.5-2 hours)



Bring people together to discuss options



Improve communication with your social worker and others



Reduce time in court

When can FCPCs be used?



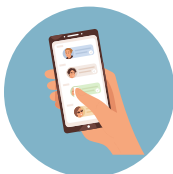
- Anytime during a child welfare matter
 - Helpful for short-term planning and quickly addressing 1-2 issues

- Free for all participants
 - Extra costs (e.g., childcare, transportation, technology) may be covered by your social worker
