What are Family Group Conferences (FGCs)?

FGCs are meetings where parents, family members, community members, and other support people develop long-term plans for a child's care. Families have private time to plan away from professionals. FGCs are organized by a facilitator who helps everyone communicate and coordinate roles.



What are the benefits of FGCs?



Plan with family and other support people



Share your voice in decision-making



Build relationships with family and other supports



Improve communication with your social worker and others



Reduce time in court





When can FGCs be used?



- · Anytime during a child welfare matter
- · Helpful for long-term planning

How much do FGCs cost?



- Free for all participants
- Extra costs (e.g., childcare, transportation, technology) may be covered by your social worker
