Mediations are meetings where parents, social workers, and other support people work through disagreements and create plans. Mediations are run by impartial mediators who encourage communication and help resolve conflict.



What are the benefits of Child Protection Mediation?



Share your opinions and participate in decisionmaking about your child



Resolve conflict



Improve communication between people



Reduce time in court



Create a legally binding agreement

When can Child Protection Mediation be used?



- Anytime during a child welfare matter
- You can have multiple mediations

How much does Child Protection Mediation cost?



- Free for all participants
- Extra costs (e.g., childcare, transportation, technology) may be covered by your social worker
