

## **Seeking Arbitration Course Designers**

Mediate BC will be developing and offering courses in arbitration and med-arbitration to support individuals expanding their conflict resolution skills and knowledge.

We are seeking course designers for three courses:

- *Law and Procedure for Arbitrators*  
This course will cover the legal regulation of arbitration, administrative law and principles of natural justice relevant to arbitration, rules of evidence, and arbitral ethics.
- *Conducting an Arbitration*  
This course will provide new arbitrators with the knowledge and skills to design and conduct an arbitration process from initial contact with the parties through decision-making and drafting.
- *Med-Arbitration*  
This course will offer an overview of med-arbitration, including design and conduct of med-arb processes and med-arb ethics.

These courses are intended to offer an accessible means for students throughout the province to access knowledge and training in arbitration. Courses created are expected to be delivered online.

## ***Qualifications***

Mediate BC welcomes applications from individuals and teams interested in working on one or more of these courses.

Individuals or teams must demonstrate:

- expertise in arbitration or med-arbitration
- a thorough understanding of the role of arbitrator

Additional preferred qualifications include:

- experience in course development and/or teaching
- experience in developing online courses.
